What is Get Into the Story? Get into the Story is a family devotional program that works in conjunction with the God's Story Sunday school curriculum*. By using this family devotional outline you will be reviewing the same lesson your child (or children) heard on Sunday morning. Like God's Story, the Get Into the Story program follows the Bible from Genesis to Revelation with a special emphasis on God's redemptive plan for His people.

Fifteen minutes a day is all you need. Try gathering the family together in the morning or just after you have finished your evening meal. Each Sunday your children are taught another part of God's Story; now it is time to Get Into the Story with your family! With Get Into the Story, we have sought to make it easy for you to lead your family through the Bible. Simply read the assigned passage with them, share the discussion notes, and ask your family the questions provided. There are five devotions for each week. This CD, (part I of the Old Testament) contains the first 40 weeks of family devotions beginning in Genesis.

Every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday you will cover a discussion point from the main passage. On Wednesday's you will explore the question, "Where is Jesus?" (for every Old Testament passage) or "Where is the Gospel?" (for every New Testament text). Each Friday you will journey on "The Road to Emmaus." Soon after His resurrection, while on the Road to Emmaus, Jesus showed two disciples how the Psalms and Prophets pointed to himself and all that had recently taken place. Following in their footsteps, you will investigate a passage from the Psalms or Prophets to discover how it points to our Savior.

Not only will all of your children be learning the same Bible passage at church, now you will have the tools to follow up with them during the week. We look forward to hearing how Getting Into the Story helped your family!
